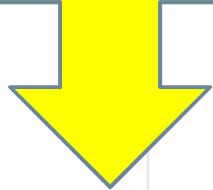

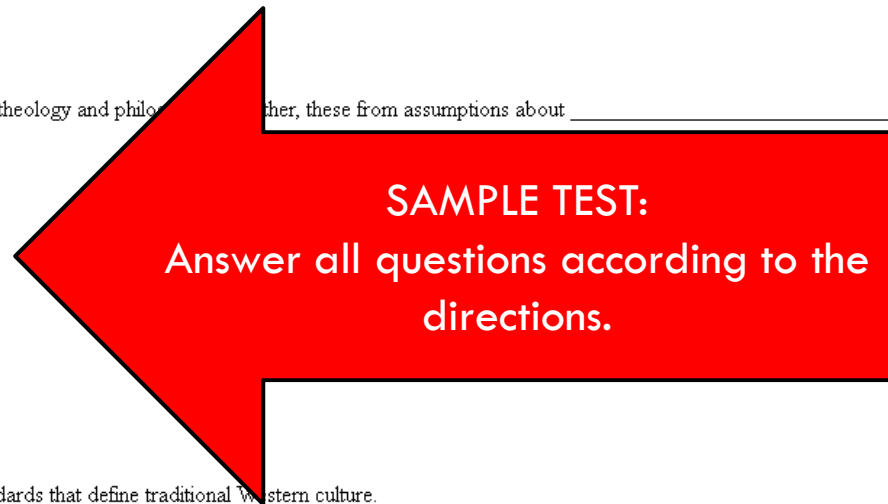

## Classroom Etiquette

### Chatting / Chat Box

- Before class begins, you may chat openly (15 minutes before class time) – **BUT NOT** after class begins
- When class begins: **No Private** chatting with other students – use “Everyone” in ‘Send To’
- If you are late: **Do NOT** enter and begin typing “Hi, sorry I’m late...” etc. It interrupts the class in progress.
- Keep Chats appropriate to the topic – don’t ramble, and **BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU SAY!**
- **Do NOT** chat while the teacher is talking. If a discussion is in progress, **STOP** chatting if your teacher asks
- For questions: use “?” or to request the mic, use “?M”. You may enter a question w/o permission **ONLY** if your teacher allows.
- Immediately when you type “?” type your questions in your chat box but **DO NOT** hit “Send.” Wait for your teacher to call on you.
- Don’t answer “No, nq, nope, etc.” when asked “are there any [more] questions.” (takes up too much chat space) . Just don’t answer.
- **Do not** go to the internet and find solutions/answers to copy-n-paste into the chat box. Teachers want to know what you know now, not by Googling the question.
- Teachers may turn off the chat feature at any time if there is too much chatter. The teacher can still see your questions, but no one else can.

### Using WebEx

- Close all Browsers, files, etc. The Virtual Classroom should be the only system running
- Sign in using **FIRST NAME** and **LAST INITIAL** only – **NO** last names
- Don’t use the “**RAISE HAND**” function unless the teacher asks you to (some teachers use it, others do not)
- **Do NOT** unmute yourself
- **Do NOT** turn on your webcam

### Audio Solutions

- Run the audio wizard or “test microphone...” when entering.
- Use “Audio” button under “Participants” box
- Remember that we are using electronics over the internet. There are slight distortions to the voice much of the time. This is normal. Get used to it and don’t let it distract you. The teacher may sound like a robot occasionally. You should be able to hear and understand 99.9% of what the teacher is saying
- If you lose audio during class for a quick second, don’t say anything. If you lose it for several seconds or more, say something. The teacher will ask if others are having difficulty. If just one student is not, then the problem is on your end. Leave the “conference” and re-enter while checking your audio. Please don’t interrupt the class by asking for others or your teacher to help.
- If you cannot fix the problem: **CALL WEBEX IMMEDIATELY AT 1-866-229-3239**
